 - Escalated enforcement action begins with a correspondence called the Enforcement Notice (ENFN) –(see <u>AQD File Naming Conventions</u>). The Enforcement Notice sets forth negotiations to administratively resolve the alleged air pollution violation.

Document	Description
Violation Notice	A letter sent to a company alleging specific violations
Enforcement Notice	Notice to the company detailing to actions that have led to the AQD taking further action
Notice of Hearing	Legal notice for the comment period.
Proposed Consent Order	Includes the proposed legal requirements agreed upon by the AQD and the Company

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
